For this assignment, I would like you to create a family tree of your family. For each person in your family, (or as many as you can) I would like you to identify the following information below their place in your family tree:

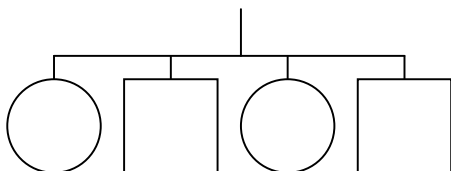
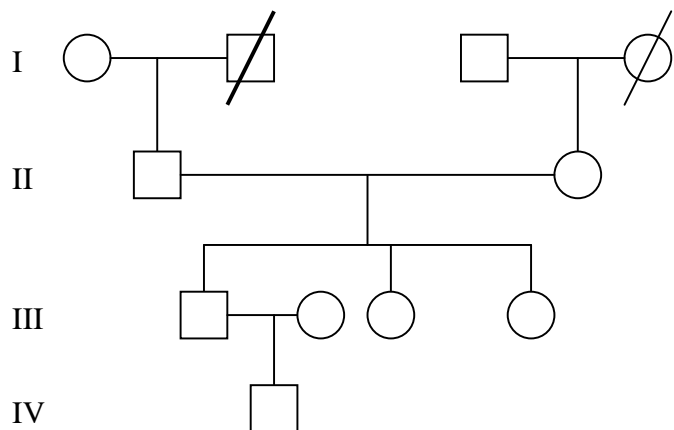
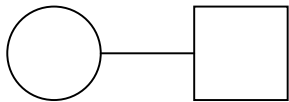
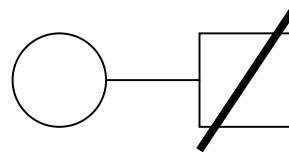
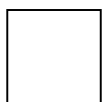
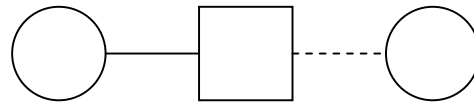
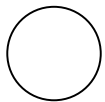
- First Name (can be a fictional name if you choose).
